

NOTICE OF ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

Paramedic Technology Program | Allied Health Department

Admissions

Apply to Mineral Area College and complete the Admissions process. The new or returning student applications can be accessed and completed online at: www.mineralarea.edu. It is the applicants' responsibility to have official high school and other college transcripts sent from the educational institution to the Admission Department at Mineral Area College.

Financial Aid

Complete a FASFA application online and submit required documentation to the Financial Aid office. For more information about financial aid, contact the Financial Aid office at (573) 518-2133.

Academic Test Scores

All paramedic applicants must complete academic testing according to the following minimum scores. The Accuplacer Next Generation testing information, practice testing and scheduling can be accessed online at www.mineralarea.edu or by calling the Assessment office at (573) 518-2202.

- ACT: English 18, Math 19, Reading 18
- Accuplacer Classic: Writing 92, Math 116, Reading 85
- Accuplacer Next Generation: Writing 250, Math 250, Reading 250

Prerequisite Courses

The prerequisite requirements for the paramedic program must be completed for a grade of C or higher by the application deadline.

- HLT 2350 Medical Terminology – 3 cr. hrs.
- PAR 2100 Paramedic Anatomy and Physiology – 3 cr. hrs.

Grade Point Average

A minimum grade point average (GPA) of 3.0. You can view your GPA by logging onto MyMAC or contacting your academic advisor.

Application

Students who meet the entrance requirements published herein must complete and submit a Paramedic Technology Program application, Reference Contact Information, type written responses to the Application Questionnaire, and other required forms.

Deadlines

All academic testing and prerequisite courses must be complete by the paramedic application deadline. It is the applicant's responsibility to request official transcripts from other educational institutions.

Personal Interview

Once eligibility is established, paramedic applicants will be required to participate in a panel interview which will be scored. The personal interview score will constitute as 25% of selection score.

Contingent Acceptance

Paramedic applicants who are selected into the paramedic program will be contingent upon meeting the following additional requirements as instructed in future correspondence following selection:
