Basic Photography \$40 MAR 17-31 Tue 6:00-8:00 pm Students will enhance their knowledge and use of perspective and composition while learning how to use the special functions of their cameras. Other topics include low-light photography, painting with light and basic digital editing, including discussions on RAW vs JPEG, color temperatures and high dynamic range. Students will also gain a better understanding of how the camera and lens work together through discussions on aperture, shutter speed, ISO and manual modes. Students should bring any type of camera with charged battery and memory card, camera manual, any additional lenses or filters, and paper and pen.

Become a Veterinary Assistant

This course, taught by a practicing veterinarian and college instructor, will give you the information you need to prepare for work in veterinary hospitals.

You will learn what vaccinations cats and dogs really need and how they should be given, the best way to control fleas, what to do if your dog has a cut, and the best way to deal with an emergency situation involving a pet. You'll also learn about pet nutrition and a variety of health and safety issues like how to treat and prevent parasites, including roundworms and heartworms. You'll explore current thoughts on spaying and neutering, and how to deal with the very emotional issues of euthanasia, pet loss, and how best to assist clients in a time of need.
