I am happy to announce the Bernadine "Bernie" Ratliff Scholarship competition for the Fall 2020 semester. Two (2) institutional scholarships in the amount of \$500.00 will be awarded to two EXCEL/SSS students for the current semester. These competitive scholarships, funded by Mineral Area College, recognize EXCEL/SSS students who are committed to academic excellence and persistence. Please read and follow the directions below carefully.

**Requirements:**

In order to be eligible for this scholarship, students must:

- Be a returning student with a minimum of 24 credit hours but no more than 60 credit hours;
- Have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5;
- Be Enrolled full-time at Mineral Area College;
- Have a current FAFSA on file with the Financial Aid Office;

If two applications are considered of equal merit, priority will be given to the student with highest unmet need;

**Preference** will be given to students who:

- Are not on financial aid warning or suspension;
- Are working toward an Associate's Degree. Students working toward a Certificate are not eligible;
- Have at least 12 in-person contacts with EXCEL tutors or advisors including a current Student Action Plan.
- Are Upward Bound or Educational Talent Search alumnus;

\* **Previous recipients** of the EXCEL/SSS Scholarship are not eligible to apply again.

**SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT:** \$500.00 (one-time award; non-renewable)

**SELECTION PROCESS:** EXCEL/SSS Office staff will review all applications for compliance with the eligibility requirements stated above. ***Those applications which are complete and which meet the eligibility requirements*** will be sent to the Financial Aid Office. The Director of Financial Aid and/or the Financial Aid Committee will make the final selection.

**APPLICATIONS:** Applications for this scholarship may be obtained in the Learning Center, EXCEL Office.

***Incomplete applications will not be considered.*** A complete application must include:

- ☐ The completed application
- ☐ A one-page essay outlining your educational goals and
- ☐ Optional letter of recommendation from an instructor
