Upon successful completion of the program, the graduate is eligible to apply to take the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN).

Satisfactory achievement on the licensure exam will qualify the program graduate for licensure as a Registered Nurse (RN).

Successful completion of the program, however, does not guarantee eligibility to take the licensure exam or to become licensed.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

1a. Be a graduate of an approved program in Practical Nursing and successfully pass the NCLEX-PN licensure exam on the first attempt within 90 days of graduation. Without successfully passing the NCLEX-PN, students will take all credit hours and clinicals in Medical-Surgical I and II.

OR

1b. Have a current Missouri license in Practical Nursing.2. Accuplacer Next Generation academic test scores with the following minimums:

- 3. Completion of prerequisite courses, *equivalent or higher* with a grade of C or above, including co-requisite, if indicated, with a grade of pass:
 - ENG 1330 [ENGL100] English Composition I
 - MAT 1240 [MATH120] Quantitative Reasoning*
 - BIO 2600 Human Anatomy
 - BIO 2620 Human Physiology
 - NUR 1290 Fundamentals of Nursing[^]

*MAT1205 Applications of College Math and MAT1230 College Algebra are accepted as equivalent courses. ^Fundamentals of Nursing or equivalent courses are accepted.

Prerequisite courses must be in progress or complete by application deadline.

- 4. Minimum grade point average (GPA) based on the five (5) prerequisite courses of: 2.5.
- 5. Completion of: BIO2600 Human Anatomy and BIO2620 Physiology by end of Spring semester (May) prior to program start date with minimum grades of C. Proof of completion or enrollment for BIO2600 and BIO2620 required with submission of application.
- 5. Successful general application and acceptance to Mineral Area College prior to nursing application deadline.
- 6. Completion of a Dosage Calculation and Medication Practicum Exam with a passing grade.

Application to the nursing program along with the requirements in this publication must be submitted by 3pm on March 7, 2025 (deadline) to the Allied Health Department at Mineral Area College.

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APPLICATION PROCESS

Nursing applications will be accepted from August 19, 2024 until 3pm on March 7, 2025. (deadline).

Assessment testing and prerequisite courses must be completed by the application deadline.

Submit the following documentation by deadline:

- Nursing application
- Application to Mineral Area College
- Accuplacer Next Generation academic test scores
- · Official copies of dual credit and transfer transcripts

Selection is based on three (3) criteria:

- GPA calculated from prerequisite courses (50%)
- Assessment test scores (25%)
- Personal interview (25%).

A personal interview with program faculty is required and will be scheduled following the application deadline prior to selection.

All applicants accepted into the program are considered on conditional status pending:

- Submission of required citizenship documentation
- Passing a drug screen
- Passing a background check
- · Compliance with immunization criteria
- Obtain Basic Life Support (BLS) Certification

1a. Applicants to the Advanced Placement program must be a graduate of an approved program in Practical Nursing and have successfully passed the NCLEX-PN licensure exam on the first attempt within 90 days of graduation.

Without successfully passing the NCLEX-PN, students will take all credit hours and clinicals in Medical-Surgical I and II.

OR

1b. Have a current Missouri license in Practical Nursing.
