Step 1	<h3>MINERAL AREA COLLEGE (MAC) APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Complete the online application for admission to MAC https://mineralarea.edu/future-students/how-to-apply/<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ New student application: This also includes dual credit students who graduated from high school and now want to attend MAC. Even though college classes were taken in high school, a new student application is still required◦ Returning student application: Those who have not attended classes for at least one semester <p>Acceptance to Mineral Area College does NOT guarantee admission into the nursing program</p>
Step 2	<h3>OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• To have transfer credits evaluated, students must request official transcripts from previous institutions to be sent to the MAC Admissions department for review• Official copies of:<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ High school transcripts<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ High school seniors can be provisionally accepted based on a seventh-semester transcript. A final transcript should be requested after graduation■ A final transcript should show grades, GPA (if available), and date of graduation■ Official high school transcripts can be sent from the high school to MAC via email: Admissions Office: admissions@mineralarea.edu◦ Home school proof of completion<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ A final transcript should show semester grades and the date of graduation◦ GED/HiSET scores<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ GED/HiSET graduates should request their official GED/HiSET transcript to be sent to MAC Admissions through

Each respective institution may also mail the transcript(s) <p>Official transcripts from previous institutions must be on file before the student is eligible to register for classes or to qualify for federal financial aid. Transcripts should arrive unopened to be considered official. Step 3	<h2 style="text-align: center;">ENTRANCE EXAM REQUIREMENT – TEAS TEST</h2> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The ATI TEAS, or Test of Essential Academic Skills, is a standardized test designed specifically to assess a student's preparedness for entering the health science fields ● Questions are designed to test the basic academic skills you will need to perform successfully in the areas of Reading, Math, Science, and English and Language Usage ● 58.7 is the minimum required composite score for the TEAS test ● If you score below 58.7%, you will need to remediate. Students must wait at least 14 days between ATI TEAS assessments ● Mineral Area College Allied Health (AH) (MAC AH) will NOT accept test scores taken before the end of the 14-day waiting period, regardless of the score obtained or location taken ● MAC AH will accept the first 4 composite scores obtained within a 12-month period. A 5th and subsequent scores will be null and void related to the MAC Nursing program selection ● ATI scores are valid for two (2) years ● If you need to retake the TEAS test, you have to retake all sections ● The entrance exam may be completed at the MAC testing Center, other approved locations, or online via the ATI proctored website (TEAS test does cost) ● Students can retake the ATI TEAS exam once every 14 days. A focused review will be available in your ATI account
